

RHODE ISLAND

In the first half of 2023, Rhode Island had 126 state hospital beds for adults with severe mental illness. This puts Rhode Island at 11.5 state hospital beds per 100,000 population. 54 state hospital beds (43%) are designated for forensic patients in Rhode Island. Rhode Island state officials did not provide official numbers for the number of forensic
